If you wish to take your bike, bike trailer or dog on bus & rail, just buy a Bicycle day- or monthly ticket. If you are a holder of a monthly ticket or a monthly subscription ticket, you can take a cycle or dog with you in the respective fare zones, free of charge.

If you use Deutschlandticket Plus Mitnahme, all regulations regarding bikes, bike trailers or dogs apply in the whole VVO region.

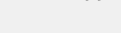

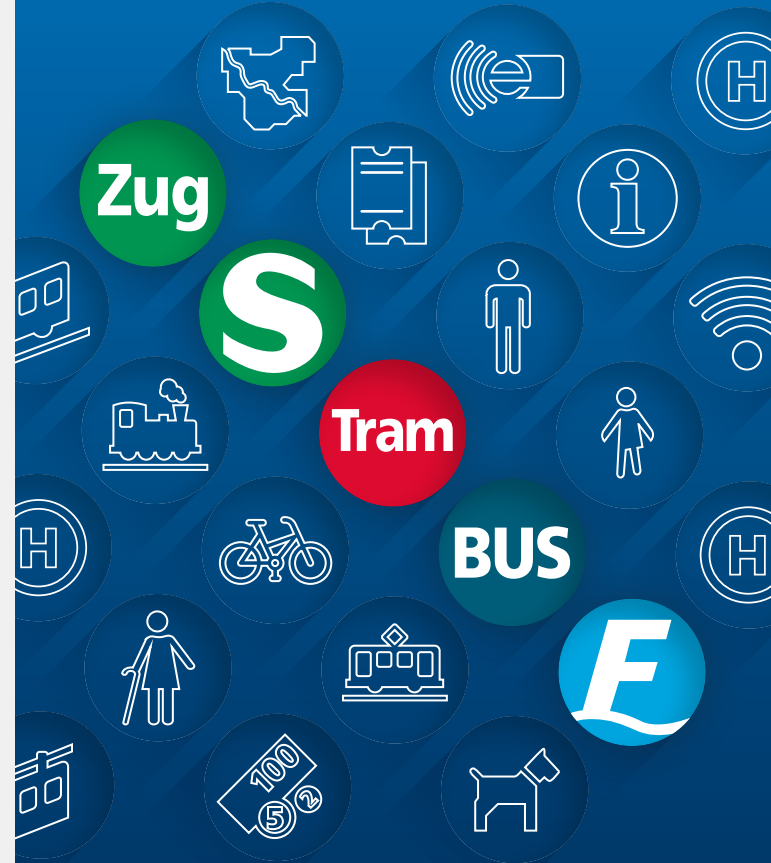

TRAVELLING THROUGH THE VVO

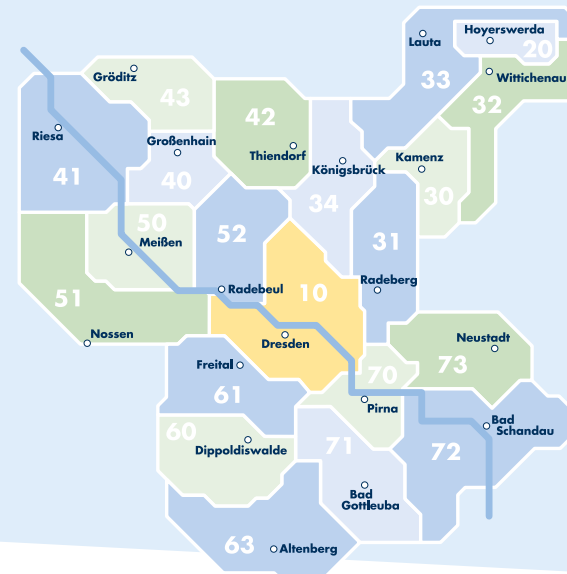
The VVO area covers the Saxon capital Dresden, the districts of Meissen and Saxon Switzerland - Eastern Ore Mountains as well as the western part of the district of Bautzen.

The region of the VVO is divided into 21 fare zones. No matter which service you use or how often you change between various modes of transport: these zones are the basis for your fare rate.

Just count the number of zones you are travelling through. The price of your ticket is displayed in the fare overview.

FARE ZONES IN THE VVO

Prices are based on number of zones travelled through.



SINGLE TICKETS

If you rarely travel with public transport we recommend our single tickets. They are available in several price categories. The price depends on the number of fare zones you are travelling in and the time you need for your trip. Almost all single tickets are available at a standard and a reduced rate. Reduced single tickets can be purchased by pupils from enrolment until the 15th birthday.

DAY TICKETS

Day tickets are a sensible alternative for single tickets when you take more than two trips per day as they allow you to travel as much as you want up to 4 am the next day. The price depends on the number of fare zones you are travelling in. They become even more attractive when used by several persons together. For example, an adult day ticket for one person entitles you to be accompanied by up to two pupils until the 15th birthday.

The family day ticket is valid for up to two adults and 4 pupils until the 15th birthday. Instead of each of the adults, a further pupil until the 15th birthday can use the ticket.

The small group ticket is valid for up to 5 persons.

SEASON TICKETS

For frequent trips with public transport we offer a wide selection of weekly and monthly tickets.

Your season ticket is valid for unlimited travel within the chosen fare zone or zones. Most tickets are issued at standard and reduced rates. Tickets at the standard rate are transferable, reduced tickets can only be used by one person and are only valid in connection with a valid customer card.



Your 7 day ticket is valid for seven days including the validation date.

Your monthly ticket is valid from the time of being stamped until the same day of the following month midnight.

The 9 o'clock monthly ticket cannot be used Mondays to Fridays (except public holidays) between 4 am and 9 am.

Furthermore monthly subscription tickets are available which are handed out as smartcard.

BILDUNGSTICKET TICKET FOR PUPILS

We offer all pupils of general schools and vocational schools without dual training this special subscription ticket for pupils, the BildungsTicket for just 15 Euros per calendar month.

Your ticket for pupils is valid for one person only. It is valid all day every day. You can travel within the whole VVO area and bring a bicycle or dog along for free. The ticket is available for a minimum duration of 12 months. It can only be used in connection with a valid customer card.

DEUTSCHLANDTICKET TICKET FOR GERMANY

The Deutschlandticket is valid in the whole of Germany in regional public transport in 2nd class. Public transport includes all regional trains (RegionalExpress, RegionalBahn and S-Bahn), trams, city and regional buses as well as most ferries – in large cities also the underground trains.

The ticket is available online as a monthly subscription ticket. The ticket is valid from the first day of a calendar month, non-transferable and includes no extras. The subscription can be terminated on a monthly basis.

If your employer offers financial support regarding your travels costs, you may buy a Deutschlandjobticket and save 30% compared to the regular ticket.

The Deutschlandticket can be extended by two extra tickets: Deutschlandticket Plus Mitnahme – includes bike or dog and extra persons within the VVO area; and Deutschlandticket Plus MOBI – includes MOBI services in Dresden. These are available as subscription tickets. Both tickets are valid per calendar month and the subscription can be terminated on a monthly basis.
